



Advanced Equine Arthroscopy Course

23st - 24nd September 2022 – Hannover (Germany)

Following the basic arthroscopy and tenoscopy courses in Hannover last autumn, we are delighted to announce that we will now be organising an advanced equine arthroscopy course. The course includes presentations on applied anatomy and arthroscopic techniques, as well as in-depth case presentations and discussions (see preliminary schedule on the next page). Four wet-lab sessions will provide substantial time to put this into practice in small groups under the guidance of experienced instructors. During these sessions, the arthroscopy stations will also be equipped with the Arthrex Nanoscope to gain experience with needle arthroscopy.
