



Basic Equine Arthroscopy Course

21st - 22nd September 2022 – Hannover (Germany)

Following the arthroscopy course in Hannover last autumn, we are delighted to announce that we will be organising another course this year. The course includes in-depth presentations on applied anatomy and arthroscopic techniques, as well as talks on the latest developments and the management of complications (see preliminary schedule on the next page). Four wet-lab sessions will provide substantial time to put this into practice in small groups under the guidance of experienced instructors. During these sessions, the arthroscopy stations will also be equipped with the Arthrex Nanoscope to gain experience with needle arthroscopy.
