

Large Animal ECVS residency position at Ghent University

Starting April 1st 2025

Prerequisites

- Be a graduate veterinarian of a veterinary college recognised by ECVS and licensed to practise in a European country
- Have completed a one-year standard rotating internship or have at least two years of clinical training in a well equipped multi-person large animal practice
- Have a good command of the English language
- A basic command of the Dutch language at the start of the program is an advantage, and this should evolve into a good written and spoken command of the Dutch language at completion of the first year of residency training.
- A basic command of the French language is advised as large part of the clientele of the clinic is French-speaking.

Program description:

- Official 3 year residency program starting April 1st, 2025. A detailed program description can be found at <https://www.ugent.be/di/en/education/internship>
- At the end of the residency and in case of favourable evolution of the program, the resident can stay enrolled for 1 additional year to allow for participation to the exam (February 2029). During that additional year, a 3 month study leave to prepare for the exam is guaranteed.
