Small Animal Surgery Residency Winchester, UK

Anderson Moores Veterinary Specialists invite applications for an ECVS-approved Standard Veterinary Surgery Residency Programme, to commence the 6th July 2020

Anderson Moores Veterinary Specialists is a busy multi-disciplinary private small animal referral hospital located within the beautiful Hampshire countryside. We are close to the historic city of Winchester (which is 1 hour from London by train) and are within easy reach of the New Forest and South Downs national parks and the Solent (for sailing). Southampton airport, an international airport serving many European destinations, is 20 minutes away.

You will be one of three ECVS residents and will join a team of around 40 referral clinicians, 5 of whom are ECVS Diplomates. You will partake in the small animal surgery referral service including contributing to the weekend emergency service and you will be encouraged to partake in clinical research projects. You must have excellent English language skills, be registered with the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons (MRCVS) or be eligible to register, be eligible to work in the UK and you must have a minimum of two years of clinical experience since graduation. Ideally candidates will have completed a rotating internship in a multidisciplinary referral centre as well as having experience of first-opinion small animal practice.

The position is for three years and will satisfy ECVS Standard Veterinary Surgery Residency requirements. Salary will be £30,000 per annum with additional benefits to include an optional pension scheme and healthcare insurance. There will be 4 weeks paid holiday each year in addition to bank holidays.

Applications should include a current curriculum vitae, a photograph (so that we can remember past and future visitors) and a hand-written letter of intent (this can be scanned and emailed) explaining why you would make a good candidate. The closing date for applications is Friday 3rd January 2020. Because of the large number of applications anticipated, visits will only be offered to candidates making an initial short-list. Interviews are likely to be in the first half of February 2020.
