

**CLINICIAN POSITION IN SMALL ANIMAL SURGERY
FULL TIME POSITION**

**Centre hospitalier universitaire vétérinaire (CHUV)
Faculté de médecine vétérinaire**

Duties : Up to 90% of efforts will be allocated to clinical service and teaching, and 10% allocated to other activities (which may include research, administration and outreach).

The successful candidate will join a team of two boarded (ACVS) faculty.

As part of clinical service duties, the successful candidate will participate in the teaching of undergraduate students, rotating interns and surgery residents.
Participation in out of-hours duties, including weekends and holidays, is expected.

Requirements :

- DVM or equivalent degree
- ACVS (American College of Veterinary Surgeons) or ECVS (European College of Veterinary Surgeons) board certification
- Individuals who are board eligible are invited to apply but preference will be given to board-certified applicants.
- The selected candidate must obtain a licence to practise veterinary medicine issued by the *Ordre des médecins vétérinaires du Québec*
- A working knowledge of the French language, or willingness to learn (institutional support is available), is essential.

Salary: Salary will be commensurate with academic credentials, experience and university salary scale. Additional compensation is provided for out-of-hours duties in accordance with the rules of the CHUV, *Université de Montréal*.

Starting date: **January 6, 2020 or sooner if the candidate is available.**
