The role involves providing clinical and teaching services in equine surgery at our state-of-the-art equine veterinary hospital and contains opportunities for professional development and is designed to fit with individual needs while working with specialists in equine medicine, equine sports medicine, theriogenology, anaesthesia and equine surgery and experienced technical staff who are focused on delivering high-quality clinical services, undergraduate and resident teaching and research. Applicants must hold a veterinary degree recognised by the Veterinary Practitioners Board of NSW, ECVS and/or ACVS and /or ANZCVS specialist qualifications in equine surgery field (senior lecturer/associate professor applicants) or completion of an ECVS/ACVS/ANZCVS registered residency (lecturer applicants). Commitment to upholding the advancement of the discipline of equine surgery and the veterinary profession through professional activity and/or research is required.

The successful candidate will be appointed to either a teaching research or teaching professional work function and will have access to the University's generous relocation support scheme.

Board certification by the European and/or the American College of Veterinary Surgeons and/or the Australian and NZ College of Veterinary Scientists or completion of an ECVS/ACVS/ANZCVS registered residency or equivalent

A record of research/creative works or professional activity relevant to the discipline, and for level C and D applicants, academic achievement at a national and/or international standing

Commitment to delivering high quality student centred learning, and for level C and D applicants,

demonstrated ability to provide effective leadership and/ or build people capability in an academic setting.
